## Counselling Registration Fee (Non-Refundable):

All candidates are required to deposit non-refundable application fee of Rs.500/- (Rupees Five Hundred Only) and should be paid through online Bank payment portal in the websites. The candidates applying under Special category should pay an additional fee of Rs.100/- (non-refundable) for each special category via Bank payment portal.

All Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Caste (Arunthathiyar) / Scheduled Tribe candidates of Tamil Nadu native are EXEMPTED from payment of the cost of the application.

## Counselling Security Deposit (Refundable):

At the time of registration, the candidate must pay Security Deposit as follows:

- For Government Medical Colleges Nil
- For Government Dental Colleges Nil
- For Government Quota seats in Self-Financing Medical / Dental College Rs.30, 000/- (if candidate wish to choice lock government quota in self financing colleges)
- Security Deposit will be refunded to the candidates after joining the allotted colleges at the end of all phases of counselling and to the candidates who have not got any seats during any phase of counselling.
- SC/SCA/ST candidates Exempted from Security deposit if annual Income is less than 2.5 Lakhs and SC candidates converted to Christianity Exempted from Security deposit if annual Income is less than 2.0 Lakhs.
- The security deposit will be refunded only to the account from where security deposit was initiated

- VI. Certificate for proof of study from VI Std. to XII Std for the candidates who have studied completely in Tamil Nadu.

- X. Documents of Parents need to be uploaded for the candidates who claim their native as Tamil Nadu as follows:
  - a. Community Certificate (Who claims communal reservation)
  - b. Either one of (SSLC / PUC / HSC Mark sheet / Transfer Certificate) or Non-literate parents should produce Non Graduate Certificate.
  - c. Either one of (Aadhar Card / Driving Licence / Voter ID)
  - d. Either one of (Ration Card / Passport)
- XI. First Graduate Certificate (if applicable) as in Annexure XIII (a) and (b) (Refer Prospectus). The candidate who claims the benefit of First Graduate should submit their certificate issued by the competent authority to their respective Colleges on securing the admission.
- XII. Special Category Form with an additional fee of Rs.100/- via Bank payment portal with relevant certificates for Persons with Benchmark Disabilities, Eminent Sports Person and Ex-Servicemen, as applicable, along with the online application form should be uploaded.
- XIII. Bonafide Certificate from Chief Education Officer is mandatory to the candidates who have studied VI Std. to XII Std in Tamil Nadu Government School for 7.5% Special Reservation as mentioned in Annexure -II (Refer Prospectus).
- XIV. Income Certificate of parent for the candidates claiming fee exemption.
- XV. Eligibility Certificate obtained from the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Guindy, Chennai for the candidates of other Universities / Boards (except State Board).
